In Jesus the man to whom life is the search for knowledge will find the supreme revelation. In Jesus the man who needs courage will find the pattern and the secret of being brave. In Jesus the man who feels that he cannot cope with life will find the Master of life and the power to live. In Jesus the man who is conscious of his sin will find the forgiveness for his sin and the strength to be good. In Jesus the pleroma, the fullness of God, all that is in God, what Westcott called "the spring of divine life," becomes available to men."

No matter how much of Christ we have experienced, there is always infinitely more! Every extravagant, and wonderful, and utterly over-the-top display of His grace in His redeemed is only a drop in the ocean of His inexhaustible fullness! I have seen many miraculous things far beyond my wildest expectations and yet I have a joyful anticipation that even greater things are on the horizon!! He cannot help Himself! It is
